Administration Updates:

Road Project:

If you have been out and about this week, you've likely noticed changes on the road project. Starting October 8th, the project will enter its next phase, which will lead to changes in traffic patterns. To clarify, the light that is being removed is not our traffic light, but rather the one located at the Chevron station. For employees and vendors entering our employee parking lot from the east on Mount Vernon, left turns will not be allowed. They will need to proceed to the main drive and turn around to head back towards Roswell Road. Attached, you will find detailed information and a map provided by the city. I encourage everyone to allow extra time for travel when planning appointments during this transition.

Scooter Policy:

We have recently encountered several accidents and disputes related to scooter use. In response, I have developed a policy regarding the use of mobility devices in the building.

This coming week, administration will reach out to those who use these devices to review the policy and secure their acknowledgment. It is crucial to remain aware of your speed, especially in hallways, the dining room, and while parking or maneuvering these devices.

Common Area Items:

I want to remind everyone that items in common areas, such as the sitting area on your floor, are not for individual appropriation as decor for personal living spaces. If you have taken items from the walls or shelves in the sitting area without permission, please return them to their original locations.



New traffic shift coming soon to Mount Vernon Highway and Johnson Ferry Road!

Here's what you can expect:

- Crews are laying down fresh asphalt and anticipating completion next week.
- The stop light at Boylston Drive and Mount Vernon Highway will be removed, and only northbound right turns from Boylston are allowed.
- The intersection near the Sandy Springs' library will have a slight change. Turning left from Mount Vernon to Johnson Ferry will be prohibited. However, drivers coming from Johnson Ferry Road towards Roswell Road are still able to make left turns.

Upcoming traffic shift: October 8, 2024

On October 8, the project will move into the next phase, which means a traffic shift will be implemented. The one-way sections of Mount Vernon and Johnson Ferry will switch to traffic lanes on the north sides of the road, while crews work in the south lane. The biggest change will be the removal of the stop light at the intersection of Boylston Drive and Mount Vernon Highway. Only northbound, right turns, from Boylston will be allowed. There will be a smaller change at the intersection closer to the library. That light isn't going anywhere (yet), but the option to turn left from Mount Vernon to Johnson Ferry is going away. If you're coming up Johnson Ferry towards Roswell Road, you'll still be able to make that left turn to continue. The attached maps detail the changes, and the pedestrian detour that will help you navigate the area.
