GREAT NEWS! The shiny new "B" elevator is currently undergoing the State's rigorous inspection as I write this. We will make an announcement as soon as we receive the green light to reopen the elevator!

The incoming gate has been open for a couple of days due to the need to replace the capacitor. This issue was repaired this morning, and the gate is now functioning properly.

The large load test on the parking deck has been successfully completed. The test involved a weight of over 300,000 pounds, resulting in a deflection of only .35 inches, which is excellent considering the allowable deflection is up to .85 inches and the expected deflection was .5 inches. The team will begin draining the water and removing the necessary shoring materials, with the goal of reopening the west side of the covered parking deck and upper deck by mid-week. This will allow displaced cars to return to their normal parking spaces and create additional space on the upper deck for the next set of vehicles needing to be moved.

On Monday, February 17th, work will commence on the roof anchors. These anchors are essential for maintenance services, such as window caulking and brick & mortar repairs. The scanning and roofing companies will be on-site to initiate the roof scanning process. Work will begin no earlier than 9 AM, and there may be some noise associated with the activities. The entire process is expected to take about three weeks, weather permitting.

Lastly, we have noticed a significant number of wine bottles in the trash rooms on Monday mornings.


