Administration

I have an important

announcement regarding the upcoming road work. From Monday, April 21, through Friday, April 25, weather permitting, contractors will be installing storm pipes across our driveway. During working hours, only one half of the driveway will be accessible. Traffic control measures, including flaggers to direct traffic, will be in place. Please be aware that there will be delays in entering and leaving the building during this time, so plan accordingly for your appointments. At the end of each workday, the driveway will be fully open; however, please exercise caution as there will be gravel and/or metal plates across the driveway.

Regarding the parking deck, Walker has granted ERI (the contractor) approval for final repairs, excluding three missing PT cables that are still under evaluation. There is a possibility that a few parking spaces may need to be vacated for these final structural repairs. If this occurs, those affected will be notified by me as soon as I have more information.

As we approach the conclusion of the first phase, I will provide a summary overview of the entire phase once it is complete. Phase 2, which includes waterproofing and other related tasks, is scheduled to begin towards the end of next week.

Maintenance/IT

Several years ago, we began installing Flood Stops, also known as water stoppers, on the toilets prior to COVID. We successfully completed floors ten, nine, eight, and some of six, and there are additional installations sporadically throughout floors one through five in no particular order. However, the item has become increasingly difficult to procure, with prices more than double. We are currently exploring another device that is similar to the ones already installed, which is more readily available and more in line with our previous pricing.

Please be mindful that many of our water intrusion issues have been solely caused by leaving bathtubs and sinks running. I strongly advise that if you feel this may be an issue for you, consider installing touchless faucets. As I have stated previously, our maintenance department can assist with this installation for a charge.

In the IT department, we are pleased to welcome Frank as our new assistant. Frank joins us in the healthcare sector and has a strong passion for IT and cybersecurity. He enjoys the outdoors and is a novice brunch enthusiast. Frank is already getting acquainted with the work order system, so you may see him knocking on your doors should you have any IT needs.
