Activities

We trust that everyone will be honest in this process and refrain from bringing personal containers to avoid taking more than one salad. Also, while grilled cheese sandwiches and BLT sandwiches are not included on the menu, they will always be available during non-chef table meal periods.

Maintenance

It has come to my attention that some of the trash rooms on the floors have been left in a disorganized state recently, with issues such as old food items, which unfortunately attract insects, and boxes that are not broken down in the recycling bins. This situation is unacceptable, and it is essential to recognize that maintaining cleanliness in the trash rooms is the responsibility of each resident on the floor, not solely the floor representatives or maintenance staff.

For your reference, please adhere to the following trash room rules:

- Trash must be placed in bags that are small enough to fit down the trash chute.
- ABSOLUTELY NO glass should ever be disposed of down the trash chute.
- A plastic bin is available for recycling clean, washed-out bottles (lids/caps, lightbulbs, and broken glass are not acceptable).
- Glass that cannot be recycled should be left on the floor of the trash room.
- A separate plastic bin is designated for newspapers, mail, magazines, and cardboard that has NOT had direct contact with food.
- Please do not include pizza boxes in the recycling.
- All cardboard boxes must be broken down; otherwise, maintenance staff will leave them in the trash room.
- Used cat litter must be double-bagged and placed in the appropriate plastic bin.

 As we transition into warmer weather, I would like to remind everyone to keep their thermostat set too automatic and to avoid leaving your balcony door open while running your AC unit. Neglecting this could lead to the unit freezing up, and you may be held responsible for any necessary repairs.
