Administration

In last week's article, I addressed the management of our trash rooms and outlined several key rules. Since then, I have received a few inquiries that merit

clarification.

Firstly, regarding the disposal of discarded food: Yes, you may place such items in a trash bag and dispose of them down the trash chute. However, I remind everyone to refrain from leaving the bag on the floor, as this can create unnecessary mess and inconvenience for others.

Secondly, concerning the conduct of residents and their hired help, such as house cleaners and caregivers, inappropriately using the trash rooms, can they be fined? Yes, if it is determined that these individuals are improperly disposing of items, the resident may be subject to fines. Thanks to residents reporting issues promptly, we can accurately identify those responsible and issue appropriate warnings and fines as necessary. Moving on to parking arrangements: If you have a designated-covered parking space and are not currently displaced due to the ongoing parking deck repairs, you are expected to park your vehicle in your assigned space.

Beginning next week, if you are found parking in the front circle or the ramp parking area without proper justification, a warning notice will be placed on your vehicle. A second violation may result in the revocation of your assigned parking space. We have noticed that many residents with assigned parking are opting to use the front circle or ramp parking instead of their designated spots. Please keep in mind that there is a waiting list for assigned covered parking, and it is not appropriate to occupy a covered space while also using side parking for your convenience.

Speaking of the parking deck, we had anticipate concluding the structural repair phase and transitioning to the next phase by the end of this week. However, additional inspections have revealed six more tendons requiring repair and three anchor pockets missing tendons from the original construction. We have approved this necessary work, which will ensure the structural integrity of the deck is fully restored upon completion.

As announced on Channel 6 and during the recent board meeting, the Kentucky Derby party has regrettably been canceled due to low participation. This event has always been a super fun occasion, and I can personally attest to the enjoyment it has brought to our community over the years. We look forward to possibly reviving it next year.
