# **ADMINISTRATION CORNER**



Happy Friday, everyone! I hope you've all had a wonderful week. Today, I'm loading up a U-Haul and driving my youngest daughter back to college for her sophomore year. Hard to believe

how fast this summer has flown by!

And speaking of time flying — next Wednesday marks my 12th anniversary here at the Towers. I can honestly say it feels like I've gained one very big, very special family over these years!

Now, down to business! I want to take a moment to address the recent power glitches we've been experiencing. Most of the time, these glitches are weather-related, but there are also many instances when they are not. Unfortunately, Georgia Power has no explanation for the non-weather-related occurrences.

So, what does this mean for us? While these interruptions may only last a second or two, they significantly impact a high-rise community like ours. Unlike a single-family home, our 10-story buildings rely on specialized equipment to deliver essential services.

When a power glitch occurs, it often disrupts or damages sensitive electronics that keep our systems running smoothly:

Booster Pump: This pump pushes water up to the condos. Without it, the individual units do not have water.

Boilers: These provide the hot water used throughout the community. A glitch can shut them down or damage their electronics, leaving the condos without hot water.

Elevators: Our elevators also depend on sensitive controls that can be knocked offline by sudden power interruptions.

Should this happen after hours and neither I nor another maintenance staff member is on-site, we must call the on-call maintenance staff member to troubleshoot or reset the systems, and in some cases, an outside technician. This could take some time, as we all know. In short, while a "flicker" of power might seem minor, it creates real operational challenges for us and can lead to costly repairs and inconvenience for us all. To address this issue, we are gathering quotes for Uninterruptible Power Supply (UPS) systems to protect these critical components—booster pumps, boilers, and elevators.

Because our equipment is large—running on 480/30–60 amps, 3-phase power—the required UPS systems are more costly but will help shield them from future power fluctuations.

This week, we met with Comcast, and the good news is they have the equipment ready for the condos and could schedule that installation quickly. The bad news is, because their construction crew is still backlogged, moving forward before the service center is complete would leave the Personal Care Center without service and the in-house channels unavailable.

Comcast has offered a temporary option to leave DirecTV service on in the Personal Care Center if we proceed with the condo installation first, but the condos would still be without the in-house channels until construction is complete.

On Monday, a survey will be sent to those who have signed up for Comcast service. You will be asked whether you prefer to move forward with the condo installation now, understanding that the in-house channels will not be available in the meantime, or wait until the construction crew completes the service center work. Please be sure to return your response so we can proceed based on your preference.

Additionally, I encourage everyone to review the Comcast scam alert memo I sent out earlier this week. I've also been in contact with Comcast to report any incidents related to this issue.

I hope you all have a great weekend, and don't hesitate to reach out to me if needed.
