### Dining

We are seeing an increase in residents visiting the dining room while feeling under the weather. As we enter flu season, please be mindful of any symptoms you may have.

Details and ordering instructions will be provided next week.

Beginning Monday, November 3rd, the Chef's Table days will move to Mondays and Tuesdays each week. This change allows for better flow in the kitchen with prepping, cooking, and overall coordination among the staff ensuring smoother operation.
