Administration

For those who have inquired about a larger, simplified Comcast remote, I have included an image of the remote on this page. If you would like to request one, please call the front desk to have your name added to the list. Please remember that this remote is not voice-activated.

I also want to remind everyone of our doormat policy at Mount Vernon Towers. As stated in our Resident Manual, and for safety reasons, doormats should not be placed in the hallways in front of your doors. Although we have been relaxed about this rule, we need to return to enforcing it to ensure our hallways remain clear and safe for everyone. If you have a doormat outside your door, please remove it immediately.

Activities & Dining

We had a successful Thanksgiving predinner party last night! Kudos to our Culinary team for the outstanding food.

Please note that on Thanksgiving Day, we will only be open during Brunch hours, from 11:30am to 2:00pm, with the last seating at 1:15pm. We will not offer breakfast or dinner that day. Additionally, on Black Friday, November 28, there will be no breakfast served or bus services that day.

For dining services, we offer free self-serve coffee and water throughout the day in the dining room. However, please remember this does not include requests for sodas or tea during non-mealtimes, as we do not provide those beverages outside regular service hours.

In preparation for our floor parties on December 1, we have started the decorating process. If you have not yet received your reservation form and floor party menu, please let me know. As a reminder, please check the Tower Talk calendar for updates, as floor parties will begin on Monday, December 1, and many activities will be shifted to Hammond Hall.

For those who book private catered events throughout the year, including December, please be aware that we are now at capacity and cannot accept any more private catered events for the remainder of 2025.

As announced last week, the Dining Room will undergo work from Friday, December 5 through Monday, December 8, during which time it will be closed. During this period, we will offer meal service only through delivery. Menus and specific ordering instructions will be provided later this week.

Maintenance

As you prepare your Christmas decorations, please remember that storage carts cannot be kept in your condos. Return them to the designated area as soon as you finish using them. Please also refrain from hanging decorations from ceilings, walls, or windows outside of your condo.

I noticed a pole attached to a wall outside a resident's door this week, which is not permitted. If you have any questions about decorating your door or common areas, feel free to reach out to me.

Lastly, I'd like to remind everyone about the Redbox located at the front desk. This is a voluntary program where residents and owners can express appreciation for our non-management staff, as employees are not permitted to accept tips throughout the year. Although contributions to this fund can be made anytime, they are especially appreciated and impactful during the holiday season.

Where Learning Once Stood

Long before Mount Vernon Towers, this very spot was home to a schoolhouse that shaped Sandy Springs.

The story begins in 1851, when the area's first school opened on Sandy Springs Methodist Church property. Children gathered in a small, one-room school across from the church. Sadly, in 1897, a fire reduced the building to ashes. But neighbors rolled up their sleeves, joined forces, and rebuilt a two-story wooden schoolhouse at what is now 300 Johnson Ferry Road.

That new school would eventually become known as Hammond School, a name remembered fondly by generations of local families.

Fun Fact: The original one-room school required parents to pay a small fee so their children could learn the basics of reading and writing—imagine paying to go to school today!
